NYFA SWEDEN HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY STATEMENT:

NYFA SWEDEN is strongly committed to encouraging our members to take part, but the health, well-being, and safety of everyone is always our paramount concern. We recommend levels of education, training, and activities dependent on age and ability, and expect our students and athletes to participate within these boundaries.”

HEALTH AND SAFETY POLICY:

To support our Health and Safety policy statement we are committed to the following duties:

- Undertake regular, recorded risk assessment of premises and all activities undertaken by NYFA SWEDEN.
- NYFA SWEDEN create a safe educational environment by putting health and safety measures in place as identified by required assessments.
- NYFA SWEDEN create a safe practical environment by putting health and safety measures in place as identified by required assessments.
- Ensure that all staff, students, and Athletes are given the appropriate level of support, training, and competition by regularly assessing individual ability dependant on age, maturity, and development.
- Ensure that all staff, students, and members are given the appropriate level of safeguarding and welfare training, regularly assessing individual competence through continuous continue professional Development opportunities (CPD)
- Ensure that all Staff, Students, athletes, and members are aware of, understand and follow the NYFA SWEDENS health and safety policy.
- NYFA SWEDEN will Annually elect a H&S officer to primarily maintain and assist with health and safety responsibilities.

- Ensure that normal operating procedures and emergency operating procedures are in place and known by all members.
- Provide access to adequate first aid facilities, telephone and qualified first aider always.
- Report, Log and investigate any injuries or accidents sustained during any NYFA SWEDEN activity or event or whilst on designated premises.
- Ensure that the implementation of the policy is reviewed regularly and monitored for effectiveness.

AS A NYFA SWEDEN STAFF, STUDENT OR ATHLETE YOU HAVE A DUTY TO:

- Take reasonable care for your own health and safety and that of others who may be affected by what you do or not do.
- Co-operate with NYFA SWEDEN on health and safety issues.
- Correctly use all equipment provided by NYFA SWEDEN.
- Not interfere with or misuse anything provided for your health, safety or welfare.
